


## What impacts does it have on everyday life?

Results of the third Expat Communication Barometer, conducted in July 2023 among 1,924 participants of which 69% have lived for more than 5 years among 128 countries in total:














### Living conditions abroad are viewed favorably overall by expatriates, despite a notable decline in purchasing power...











